We have the following questions regarding the High School #13 9C Wood Flooring Rebid.

1. In spec section 096400 Wood Flooring for Gymnasiums F706 and F908 2.01 Maple Floor System A. Aacer Flooring is listed as an equivalent flooring system but is not listed for the Dance D508, or Stage E505. We are asking that Aacer flooring be listed as an equal for the Dance floor and Stage floors.
2. In specification 096400 it calls out that the wood flooring should finger jointed or tongue and grove jointed continuous strip. Aacer flooring makes tongue groove random length MFMA-RL maple flooring. Is RL acceptable?
